

MedicaExpert Information Clause [GDPR]

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of the General Data Protection Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC ("GDPR"), we hereby advise that:

1. The Joint Controllers of your personal data are:

MedicaExpert Conference Mateusz Lubarski with its registered office in Miechów (32-200) at ul. Wesola 9, NIP: 6591496495, correspondence address: ul. Bociana 4A/63; 31-231 Kraków. Detailed information concerning the principles of personal data processing can be found in the Privacy Policy.

2. Your personal data shall be processed for the following purposes:

- a. related to the processing of the application and the execution of the conference or scientific and training event, on the basis of the explicit consent granted and the agreement concluded (Article 6(1)(a) and (b) of the GDPR);
- b. related to compliance with legal obligations, such as insurance, accounting, tax, and archiving obligations, pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR;
- c. for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Controller, including the promotion of its activities and the establishment, exercise, or defense of potential legal claims, pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR.

3. The provision of your personal data is strictly voluntary; however, a refusal to provide such data shall preclude the Controller from executing the agreement. The Controller collects the following categories of data: identification data, contact details, and invoicing data.

4. The data shall be retained by the Controller for the period strictly necessary to fulfill the aforementioned purposes and obligations arising from specific legal provisions—until the Controller fulfills the necessary legal obligation incumbent upon it. In the event of data processing based on the consent granted—until its withdrawal, and upon its withdrawal, further

archiving shall ensue for a period necessary for the potential establishment and exercise of rights and legal claims.

5. The Controller is authorized to transfer your personal data to third parties for the purpose of, and to the extent necessary for, compliance with obligations arising from the provisions of law, including the Social Insurance Institution (ZUS), the Tax Office (US), inspection, supervisory, or auditing bodies, as well as for the proper and due performance of the Controller's duties and in connection with the execution of the Conference, i.e., to entities supporting the Controller in its business operations: postal and courier service providers, providers of legal and advisory services, IT service providers, and entities conducting payment activities (banks, financial institutions).

6. Personal data shall not be transferred to third countries or international organizations.

7. Subject to the limitations arising from the GDPR and other provisions of law, you are vested with the right to request access to your personal data, its rectification, erasure, or restriction of processing, as well as the right to data portability, the right to object to processing, and the right to withdraw your consent at any time, provided the processing is based on your explicit consent.

8. Furthermore, please be advised that you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority should you deem that the processing of your personal data infringes upon the provisions of the GDPR.
